



## Letter of Guarantee

Best Sanitizers, Inc. certifies that ALPET E3 complies with earlier USDA guidelines for E3 Hand Sanitizing Compounds for use as a hand sanitizer in food processing and food handling areas in official establishments operating under the Federal Meat and Poultry Inspection Program. This certification is based on a review by Best Sanitizers, Inc. establishing that ALPET E3 meets current FDA and USDA requirements for Hand Sanitizers. ALPET E3 was previously authorized as an E3 Hand Sanitizing Compounds. ALPET E3 is used undiluted and should be dispensed from Best Sanitizers, Inc. dispensers. When used following label instructions, ALPET E3 is safe and effective as a Hand Sanitizing Compound and will not adulterate food products when used following label directions.

### E3 Hand Sanitizing Compounds

The compounds must be dispensed from adequate dispensers located a sufficient distance from the processing line to prevent accidental contamination. The hands must be washed and thoroughly rinsed prior to sanitizing with the compound. The hands need not be rinsed with potable water following the use of the compound. The compounds must always be used at dilutions and according to applicable directions provided on the label. The compounds have been accepted on the basis of their equivalency to 50 parts per million chlorine.

The final granting of authorization for the proposed use of such compounds is the responsibility of the Inspector in Charge of the official plant. Best Sanitizers, Inc. will provide technical assistance on request.
