## **Letter of Guarantee**

Best Sanitizers, Inc. guarantees that ALPET D2 is an effective Surface Sanitizer and will not adulterate food products under the intended conditions of use as outlined on the product label. Best Sanitizers, Inc. certifies that ALPET D2 Surface Sanitizer complies with earlier USDA guidelines for D2 Sanitizers for all surfaces not always requiring a rinse: for use as a sanitizer in food processing and food handling areas in official establishments operating under the Federal Meat and Poultry Inspection Program. This certification is based on a review by Best Sanitizers, Inc. establishing that the product meets current EPA, FDA and USDA requirements for Food Contact Surface Sanitizers. ALPET D2 Surface Sanitizer is formulated to meet 21 CFR 178.1010, 40 CFR 180.940 and 180.950. The product is used undiluted and should be dispensed from Best Sanitizers, Inc. dispensers. It has been certified by NSF as a D2 compound, the number is 126509.

## D2 Sanitizers not always requiring a rinse

Before using these compounds, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the room or carefully protected. A potable water rinse is not required following use of these compounds for sanitizing previously cleaned hard surfaces provided that the surfaces are adequately drained before contact with food ensuring that little or no residue remains which can adulterate or have a deleterious effect on edible products. These compounds may be used for microbial control on ceiling, floors, and walls at concentrations higher than those allowed for sanitizing food contact surfaces without potable water rinse unless in the opinion of the inspector in charge as such use may result in contamination of food products. A potable water rinse is required following use of these compounds under conditions other than those stated above.

The Compounds must always be used at dilutions provided on the EPA registered label and according to applicable directions. The final granting of authorization for the proposed use of such compounds is the responsibility of the Inspector in Charge of the official plant. Best Sanitizers will provide technical assistance upon request.
